
- PUBLISHED RESEARCH IN FIELDS
- SEVERAL LEVELS OF QUALITY
 - PEER-REVIEWED
 - GREY

TYPE	EXAMPLE	LEVEL
SYSTEMATIC REVIEW	COCHRAN REVIEW	■
PEER-REVIEW ARTICLE	JOURNAL ARTICLE	■
RESEARCH REPORT	EVAL REPORT ON GOV'T SITE	■
ONLINE + PRINT MEDIA	WEBSITE NEWSPAPER	■

STEPS TO SEARCHING THE RESEARCH LITERATURE

1. DEFINE WHAT YOU ARE LOOKING FOR
2. SEARCH TERMS
3. ACCESS DATABASE
4. ENTER SEARCH TERMS
5. TRY "SYSTEMATIC REVIEW"

NARROWING DOWN THE SEARCH

- REFINE THE TIME PERIOD
 - SCAN THE ARTICLES
 - HEADING
 - CITATION NUMBERS
 - LINK TO PDF
 - DECIDE ON THE NUMBER OF ARTICLES TO LOOK AT
-

1. PROGRAM MODEL

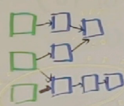
- INCLUSION OF SPOUSE + FAMILY MEMBERS.

2. OUTCOMES + PATHWAYS

- ENJOYMENT
- EMPOWERMENT
- FEELING PART OF COMMUNITY
- INCREASED AWARENESS
- CHANGED ATTITUDES
- REDUCED STIGMA

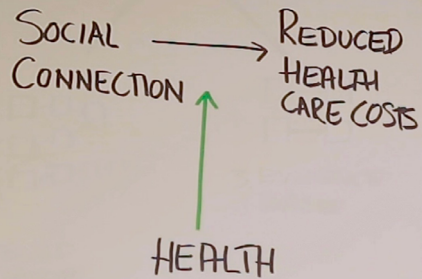
