Is the transcript dominated by words of the interviewee? (Is there considerably more diaglogue from interviewee compared to interviewer)						
Is there evidence of <b>rapport building</b> ? (usually at beginning of the interview)						
3. Do the interviewee's responses appear <b>authentic</b> ? (do they seem relaxed and comfortable with the interview process?) -Note- This is often more evident in video or audio recording.						
4. Are the questions asked by the interviewer clear and singular (not ambiguous or double-barreled)?						
5. Are the interviewer's questions dominated by open- ended questions?						
6. Are closed-ended questions kept to a minimum?						
7. Does the interviewer use probes and prompts throughout the interview to gain more depth of response?						
8. Do the interviewees responses provide a <b>depth of experience</b> ? - i.e. as a reader can you get a clear picture of the what, when, how and who of what their experience (including context, throughts and experience).						
9. Are <b>leading, loaded or biased</b> questions avoided?						
10. Does the interviewer <b>refrain from judgement</b> (both positive and negative) through the interview?
